**Integration and Automation Progress**


- The library is implementing an Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) using SOUL 2.0 software, which has already been acquired.
- Efforts are underway to create a centralized database to streamline library operations and ensure a unified digital system.

**Current Functionalities**

- Databases for teaching faculty, final-year UG students, and stock entries of new arrivals are already functional within the SOUL 2.0 platform.
- The Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) module of SOUL 2.0 is operational, enabling library staff to provide instant updates on book availability and status.


**Supplementary Practices**
