6.5.1 - Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes

The following are the major incremental improvements and quality initiatives taken up by the IQAC:


The IQAC organizes seminars, workshops, conferences, and endowment lecture series to enhance quality in research, teaching, and assessment, while encouraging teachers to actively participate in these initiatives. It also motivates teachers to adopt more engaging and effective teaching methods, incorporating ICT to improve the learning experience.

The IQAC collects feedback from stakeholders on various aspects, including teaching quality, infrastructure, library services, and teaching-learning and evaluation facilities. It promotes both academic and personal development by organizing workshops, seminars, exhibitions, competitions, and encouraging greater student participation in curricular, co-curricular, and extension activities.

The IQAC oversees staff and student involvement in extracurricular and curricular activities, ensuring detailed instructions and proper documentation. The Action Taken Report (ATR) confirms that the planning and execution of these programs have been carried out satisfactorily.

Additionally, IQAC plays a key role in coordinating and implementing the institution's best practices. It, along with the Heads of Departments, conducts an annual peer review as part of the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) to assess teaching and learning practices, infrastructure, faculty quality, and other key areas to ensure high standards of education.

A primary responsibility of the IQAC is to prepare the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) based on the guidelines and parameters set by NAAC.


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
