The techniques adopted by the IQAC to check periodically the Teaching learning process, structures & methodologies of operations and learning outcomes are as follows:


The College strictly adheres to its timings and maintains discipline. The preparation of the timetable, along with unit/lesson planners, is done in advance. A Student Handbook, which includes rules, regulations, the Almanac, and the academic calendar, is distributed to students.

The College ensures the provision of adequate infrastructure to create a conducive teaching-learning environment. Regular supervision is conducted for both theory and practical classes, with student attendance monitored and mentoring provided.

Study materials are made available, and teaching diaries, academic records, and attendance registers are regularly reviewed. The College organizes guest lectures, seminars, and industrial visits to enhance learning. Remedial classes are arranged for slow learners, and skill-based testing (SBT), internal assessments, and end-semester exams are carefully monitored.

Feedback is gathered from students, and Parent-Teacher meetings are held regularly. The departments submit statements verifying the completion of the syllabus, which are consolidated for review.

The IQAC, along with Heads of Departments, conducts a peer review annually as part of the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA). This review evaluates the continuous enhancement of teaching-learning practices, infrastructure and ICT facilities, teacher quality, and other key factors, aiming to maximize the potential of both faculty and students for high-quality education. The audit includes internal evaluations to assess and analyze the compliance of academic and administrative systems.


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
